Introduction

Welcome to the Airways Aviation Foundation Course.

It is suitable for students with little or no prior aviation knowledge and provides a clear route into formal flight training with Airways Aviation.

Course Overview

The Airways Aviation Foundation Course introduces students to the fundamentals of aviation and prepares them for progression into **EASA** or **CASA** approved Commercial Pilot Licence (CPL) training.

Graduates of this program gain confidence in aviation studies and the knowledge required to begin professional pilot training.

Duration & Mode of Study

• Course Length: 4 weeks

• Mode: Full-time classroom study

• Contact Hours: Approximately 25 hours per week

Course Modules

The course is delivered across **nine core modules**, each focusing on a key area of aviation theory:

- Aviation English
- Principles of Flight
- Aircraft General Knowledge
- Flight Radio Communication
- Human Factors
- Meteorology
- Air Law and Procedures
- Navigation
- Performance & Planning



Teaching & Learning

- Interactive classroom lectures and group discussions
- Practical workshops and case studies
- Digital resources provided online (students bring their own iPad)
- Extra activities such as guest lectures, simulator sessions, and visits to airport facilities

Assessment & Completion

- Each subject module concludes with a multiple-choice test
- A minimum pass mark of 75% is required per subject
- Students who successfully complete the course receive a Certificate of Successful Completion
- Students who attend but do not pass may receive a Certificate of Attendance

Pathways After the Foundation Course

Successful graduates may progress into Airways Aviation's flight training academies in:

- Finland
- Italy
- Portugal
- Australia

Here, students can enrol in **EASA** or **CASA** Commercial Pilot Licence (CPL) programs for aeroplanes.
